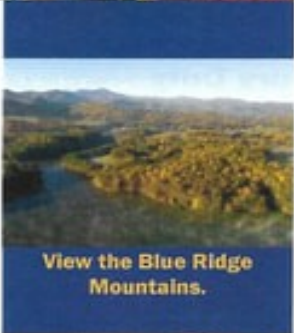

Scholarships

One of the ABWC main objectives is to provide scholarships for high school graduates going to college. The committee is looking forward to interviewing students residing in Apollo Beach (33572) and/or are zoned to attend East Bay or Lennard high school.



The scholarship application and criteria have been placed on our website: <http://www.apollobeachwomansclub.com/scholarship-info.html> . We hope members will become familiar with the criteria so you can promote the scholarship program with your family, friends and acquaintances.

The scholarship amounts are \$700 for Hillsborough Community College (two year degree) and \$1,500 for a four year accredited Florida college or university. The money may be used to cover tuition, books, and fees.

If students attend East Bay or Lennard High School, applications are due on February 20 to the Guidance Counselor at the high school. Other students meeting the residency requirements will mail the applications to Sharon Vasquez by February 20.

The committee will be going to Lennard and East Bay high school on Monday, March 9 to interview students. Students who meet qualifications and are selected to receive scholarships will be recognized at the May 13 luncheon along with their parents.

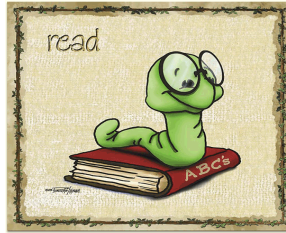

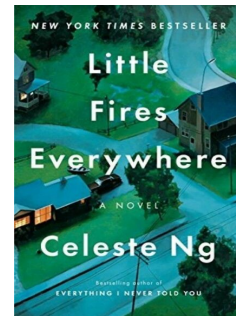

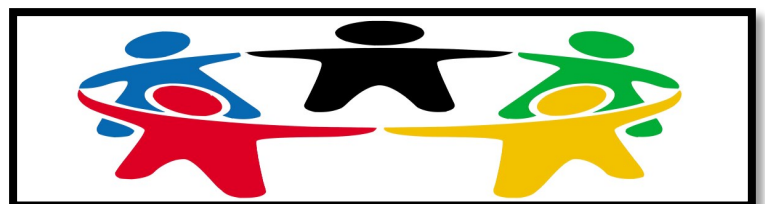
A Merry Christmas to Families in Need
